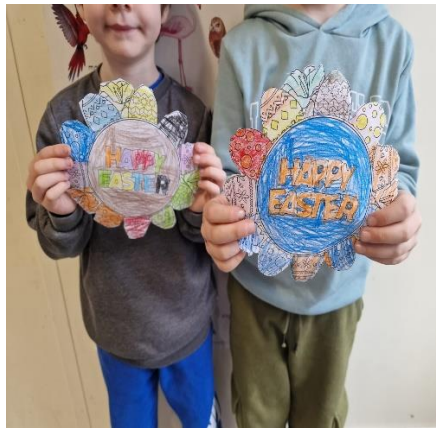




Easter
