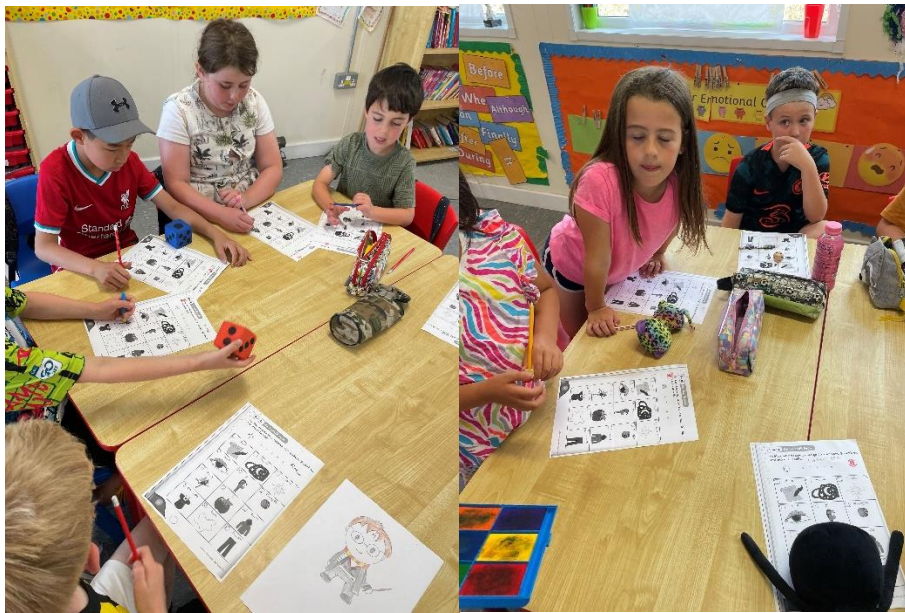


Literacy
