# Senior Infants - January Review

### Literacy

Following the inspectorate's report, we have put an emphasis on handwriting and writing this month. Our writing theme was explanation writing and the children enjoyed exploring their creative side describing what 'The Gruffalo' from Julia Donaldson's book looks like as well as describing Anger. The children wrote some wonderful explanation pieces about these and below are some pictures. In literacy this month we have also been doing stations with Leigh on Wednesdays focusing on tricky words.





### **Numeracy**

In numeracy this month, we explored time. The boys and girls discussed things they might do during the day versus night time. The children learned the days of the week and the four seasons. The children have also been learning all about the number 8 this month.



# Gaeilge

In Gaeilge this month, our theme has been Éadaí (clothes). Some of the vocabulary the children learned was hata (hat), bríste (trousers), scairf (scarf), geansaí (jumper), cóta (coat), t-léine (t-shirt), brógaí (shoes), gúna (dress) and sciorta (skirt). The children learned the following phrases also:

Cuir ort do.... (put on your...)

Bain díot do..... (take off your...)

Cad atá sa chófra éadaí? (What is in the closet?)

Tá \_\_\_\_\_\_ sa chófra éadaí. (\_\_\_\_\_ is in the closet)
