Senior Infants - April Review


Dear Parents/Guardians,

Below is a brief overview of what we got up to during April:

Literacy

This month, the children have been using their dictation skills to write sentences on their whiteboards. The boys and girls always love this challenge. The children have been learning about the magic e and spelling and identifying words with the magic e in them – hide, slide, bake, cake, huge etc. Also, the boys and girls have been doing some fantastic writing in their SESE copies such as the life cycle of a butterfly and sunflower.



Numeracy

During numeracy this month, the children learned about money. We focused on coins - 1c up to €2 coins. We discussed the value of these and different things you might get in a shop with a €2 coin etc. We have just begun learning about time this week. The children made their own clocks and we have started learning o'clock.
